

UNATTENDED CHILD POLICY

In keeping with Safety and Use Bylaw, the Lethbridge Public Library welcomes all children to use its facilities and services, but it cannot be responsible for their safety and supervision. For the safety and comfort of children, it is the policy of the Lethbridge Public Library Board that parents, guardians, or other adult caregivers accompany children while they are using the Library and its services. Parents and caregivers are to be solely responsible for the safety and supervision of their children. The Library staff is not responsible for children left unattended in Library facilities or on surrounding premises.

Children age five and under must be accompanied by a parent/guardian/caregiver at all times. Children ages six to nine are to be accompanied by a parent/guardian/caregiver who must remain within library facilities. Children aged 10 and older may visit the Library independently on terms determined by their parent/guardian.
